Notes From Your Session

Session met on Wednesday, March 17 at 6:00 PM in the church Hudson Room. Rev. Dave Roberts, as promised, began our meeting by showing us the relationship between Scripture and The Book of Order. Session has agreed that this will not only help each of the elders but a basis for learning our duties.

Rev. Roberts then opened the meeting with prayer.

The Clerk reported the Court of Common Pleas has requested to us our church social hall for the purpose of beginning an Outreach Program for recovering substance abusers. The group known as Celebrate Recovery is meeting in Toronto and would like to begin a chapter in our county. The Session unanimously approved this and the Clerk will inform the court and will advise Session when the meetings will begin. Dianna Albright agreed to be assistant clerk, if in some case, the present clerk might be absent from a meeting.

The Finance Committee report was given by Chairman Dave Misko. Our investments are doing quite well as was shown on the report. A discussion was held on the use of our per capita charges explaining that the funds are used to support the Upper Ohio Valley Presbytery, Synod of the Trinity, Disaster Relief and many other ways our denomination supports its ministry. Dave also made note that the church does pay for those who may not realize the payment is due.

The Outreach and Evangelism had no meeting so obviously there was no report.

Music and Worship Committee chairman Paul Moore reported that the pulpit is filled through April 11th with John Visser speaking through April 4th and Carolyn Kibble April 11th. The Trustees report was read by session and approved. A new security system is being ordered as the present system isn't functioning properly. The General Restoration firm that did the masonry work several years ago has been contacted due to problems with moisture seepage in the two towers. The firm reported that with the electric power lines along Muskingum Street are too close to the building to allow safe access and to request AEP to move the lines is far too great of an expense.

Cathy Rose reported that the contact person to help in the purchase of AED's (Automated External Defibrillators) has yet to contact Cathy's phone call. By next meeting a full report may be given.

The Pastor Nominating Committee report was given and there is a copy of that report in this newsletter.

John Visser was approved to be the Session's rep at the trustees meeting.

RE Jackie Hutjera was re-appointed as Commissioner to the Upper Ohio Valley Presbytery.

A very positive and lengthy discussion was held regarding Christian Education and what direction we must pursue to begin offering a good Christian Education not only to the youth of our church but all of our congregants. Plans will be brought before Session at their April meeting and a Christian Education Committee will then be formed to pursue these plans possibly to be implemented in September.

The meeting was adjourned with prayer by Rev. Roberts.

The Committee had its first meeting on March 1, 2020 at 7:00 PM with Rev Darrin Jones, the Upper Ohio Valley Presbytery's Committee on Ministry (COM) assigned pastor to lead us through the process of calling another pastor.

Rev. Jones led us through a number of areas which we must consider the least of which is the formation of a Mission Study which will help us in forming guidelines which will aid in completing the Ministry Information Form (MIF). This form, when completed will then be presented to the COM for approval and we will then be presented a list of eligible candidates seeking the calling of a particular church.

A couple of things Rev. Jones stressed is that you, the congregation, must take an active part in this process and that the perspective pastor need not and may not be from Presbytery.

He stressed also that we must meet as a committee and discuss our ideas and those we receive from the congregation on a regular basis.

On this advice the committee met on March 10 in the Social Hall. A number of handouts were given to the committee to be reviewed before the next meeting of March 24. Much of the discussion was what the committee saw with our history of the past four years. And a number of items about those four years was discussed.

The committee now feels that we have the basis for beginning to build from past mistakes and move in a positive direction only with the guidance from Rev. Jones and the suggestions coming from surveys that will be present to the congregation.
